
About us:-

Incorporated in 1989, Bhageria Industries Limited is engaged in manufacturing of Dye and Dye-Intermediates, Pharmaceutical and Solar. The company has its plant located at Vapi and Tarapur. Vinyl Sulphone, H-Acid and Gamma Acid are major products of the company. Nearly 50% of the production is being exported worldwide to various clients including multinationals. Products are being exported to Korea, Japan, Taiwan, China, Germany, U.S.A & other European and African countries.

Further, the company is also present in solar power generation. Bhageria Industries Limited has 39MWdc Solar Power Plant at Ahmednagar, Maharashtra and a 4.78 MW operational Solar Rooftop projects majorly located in Chennai.

From Last few years Bhageria Industries limited addresses different social issues of society and worked on it with the help of Corporate Social Responsibility. In the year 2022-2023, Company CSR majorly focuses on the Education and Health sector of society. CSR of a company is used for the betterment of the marginalized people.
